# WHAT DOES RAMADHAN MEAN?

**What does the Quran say about Ramadhan?**

According to the Quran,

"Ramadhan is the month in which the Qur'an was revealed as a guide for humanity with clear proofs of guidance and the standard to distinguish between right and wrong. So whoever is present this month, let them fast. But whoever is ill or on a journey, then let them fast an equal number of days after Ramadhan. Allah intends ease for you, not hardship, so that you may complete the prescribed period and proclaim the greatness of Allah for guiding you, and perhaps you will be grateful."

(Al-Qur'an 2:185)

Pronounced: Ra-ma-dawn) :Ramadhan (رمضان)

# WHAT IS FASTING & WHO IS REQUIRED TO FAST?

---

---



## The importance of fasting

Fasting is one of the five, essential pillars of Islam.

## What does fasting mean?

It means to refrain oneself from certain actions that invalidate the fast (such as eating, drinking etc).

Fasting starts from the time of dawn (Subuh/Fajr) and lasts until dusk (Maghrib).

Fasting is stipulated on a...

1. Muslim, be it male or female.
2. Person who has reached the stage of puberty.
3. Person who is of a sane mind.
4. Woman who is not in the state of menses or post-natal bleeding.
5. Person who is healthy to fast.

# RULES OF FASTING - SETTING INTENTION



## Intention

The intention of fasting needs to be made every single night, anytime from Maghrib till Fajr. The minimal way of making your intention is to acknowledge in your heart that you will be fasting the next day. And it is better to mention the intention by word.

نَوَيْتُ صَوْمَ غَدٍ عَنْ أَدَاءِ فَرَضِ شَهْرِ رَمَضَانَ  
هَذِهِ السَّنَةِ لِلَّهِ تَعَالَى

"I intend to fast tomorrow to fulfill this year's Ramadhan obligation for the sake of Allah"

"Nawaitu sauma ghadin an'adai fardi syahri ramadhani hadzihisanati lillahita'ala"

As recommended by some scholars such as Syeikh Omar Al Khatib, May Allah benefit us from him:

One should make the intention to fast for the whole of Ramadan on the first night and continue to make the intention every night. This is to ensure that in any of the nights, if one forgets to make intention, his/her fast would still be valid.

## Acts that break/invalidate the fast:

- Consumption of food and drinks
- Sexual intercourse
- Self-induced vomiting
- Insertion of substance into a body cavity
- Menstruation & post-natal bleeding



# OBLIGATORY ACTS IN RAMADHAN

## Fasting

The Messenger of Allah, may blessings and peace be upon him said: “Allah the Majestic and Exalted said: Every (good) deed of the son of Adam would be multiplied, a good deed receiving a tenfold to seven hundredfold reward. The Prophet ﷺ said: Allah says: Fasting is for me I shall reward for it. And the fasting person has two moments of joy: When he breaks his fast and when he meets his Lord.

(Narrated by Imam Muslim)

What this hadith means is that all our good actions are rewarded by Allah and multiplied by him anywhere from 10 to 700 times. Except for Sawm (fasting). This is because fasting is rewarded only by Allah and how much reward we receive for every fast is known only to Him.

## Obligatory Zakat (Zakat Fitrah)

Zakat fitrah can be paid from the first night of Ramadhan until before the start of Aidilfitri prayer. The rate that is obligatory on every person is one sa' or 2.3kg of the staple local food. In Singapore, the staple food is rice.

You can refer to MUIS on how to make this payment.

## Consciousness of Allah

Allah says in The Qur'an 3:76:  
" ...Surely Allah loves those who are mindful of Him."

In this verse, Allah describes his love for those who are mindful of Him.

Allah also says in The Qur'an 2:183:  
"O believers! Fasting is prescribed for you—as it was for those before you—so perhaps you will become mindful of Allah".

Then in this verse, Allah educates the main reason behind why fasting is prescribed, which is to be mindful of him.

## Gratitude & Sincerity

Allah says in The Qur'an 14:7:  
"And remember that your Lord promised, 'If you are thankful, I will give you more, but if you are thankless, My punishment is terrible indeed"

The question comes: "Isn't gratitude only meant for the good things in life?"

Reflecting upon ourselves and the blessings of Allah helps us develop a sense of gratitude, despite being tested by God with hardship. With every ordeal, there is also ease and comfort. Every test that befalls upon us is for our own good, and Allah S.W.T does not burden anyone beyond his/her capacity (2:286). It is possible that we hate a thing which is good for us, and love a thing that is bad for us, and Allah knows, and we do not know. (2:216).

## Peace

Among the 99 Names of Allah is 'As-Salaam' which means The Giver of Peace.

Allah says in The Qur'an 60:8  
"Allah does not forbid you from dealing justly and kindly with those (Non-Muslims) who did not fight against you in the matter of religion nor drove you out of your land. Surely Allah loves the doers of justice"

Abdullah ibn Mas'ud reported: The Messenger of Allah, (PBUH), said, "Verily, peace is among the names of Allah he has placed on the earth, so spread it among yourselves.

If a man greets people with peace and they answer him, he is favored a degree over them as he has reminded them. If they do not answer him, he is answered by angels who are better and purer than them." (Narrated by Imam Thabrani)

As Muslims, we are constantly reminded by Allah SWT and The Prophet Peace be Upon him, to spread peace. Muslims greet each other daily with "Assalamualaikum" which means "Peace Be Upon you"

May Allah make us amongst the ones who spread and love peace!

## Compassion

Among the 99 names of Allah are “Ar-Rahmaan” which means The Most Compassionate.

Allah says in The Qur’an 25:63  
“The true servants of the Most Compassionate are those who walk on the earth humbly, and when the foolish address them improperly, they only respond with ‘peace’.”

In this verse above Allah specifically mentions “The True Servants of the Most Compassionate”

It was reported that the Prophet PBUH said, "Allah is compassionate and loves compassion. He gives for compassion what He does not give for harshness." (Narrated by Imam Bukhari)

Through being compassionate to the creations of Allah SWT, one will attain the love of Allah SWT. The Prophet (PBUH) was the mirror of Allah’s compassion. He encountered many resistance throughout his journey of spreading Islam, yet he prayed for the ones who wronged him, despite being hurt.

The day of Ta’if was said to be the most difficult day faced by the Prophet (PBUH). The Prophet was offered by the angels of the mountains to crush the people of Ta’if due to their harsh and bloody treatment towards the Prophet. Instead of wanting them to be destroyed, The Prophet replied : "I rather hope that Allah will raise from among their descendants people who will worship Allah the One, and will not ascribe partners to Him (in worship)." (Narrated by Imam Bukhari and Muslim)

## Generosity

Among the 99 Names of Allah is 'Al-Kareem' which means the Most Generous.

Sahl ibn Sa'd reported: The Messenger of Allah, peace and blessings be upon him, said, "Verily, Allah is generous. He loves generosity and the highest morals, and He detests pettiness."

(Narrated by Imam Baihaqi)

Ibn Abbas R.A said that The Prophet, Peace Be Upon him was the most generous of all the people and he used to reach the peak of generosity in the month of Ramadhan. This is a trait that is loved by Allah SWT that we could build in Ramadhan.

Allah says in The Qur'an 2:267-268: "O believers! Donate from the best of what you have earned and of what We have produced for you from the earth. Do not pick out worthless things for donation, which you yourselves would only accept with closed eyes. And know that Allah is Self-Sufficient, Praiseworthy."

"The Devil threatens you with the prospect of poverty and bids you to the shameful deed of stinginess, while Allah promises you forgiveness and great bounties from Him. And Allah is All-Bountiful, All-Knowing."

## Patience

Among the 99 Names of Allah is 'As-Saboor' which means The Extensively Patient One.

Allah says in The Qur'an 3:146  
"...And Allah loves those who are patient."

Imam Al-Ghazali mentioned:

"The speciality of fasting is forbearance and sacrifice, as it is the action of the mind as secret from the public eyes, unlike all other actions that fall within the human eyes. Nobody sees fast except Allah as it is a secret action that requires sincere patience."

(Ihya' 'Ulumuddin Chapter on Fasting)

## Ramadhan Journey

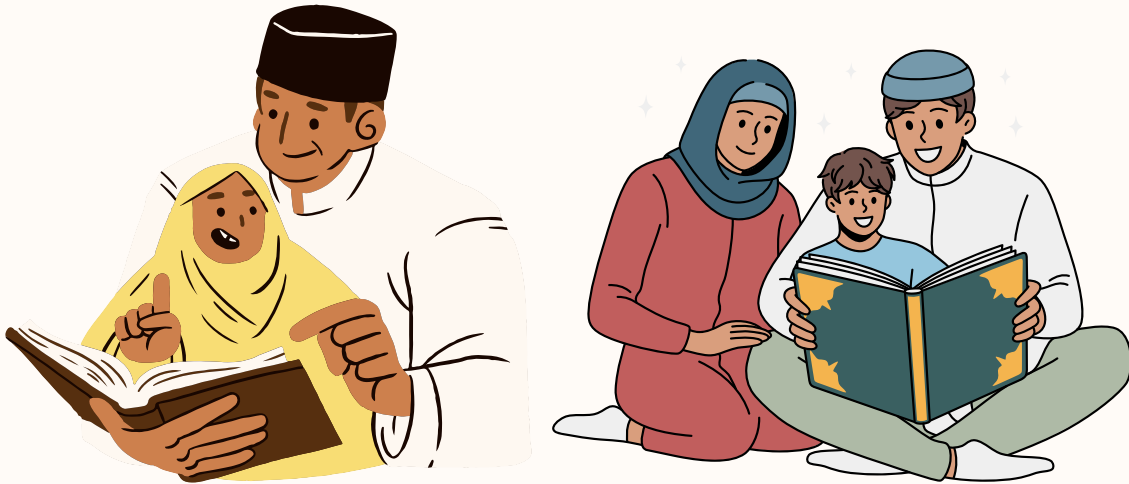

## **Increase in reading the Book of Allah**

The month of Ramadhan is also known as The month of Al-Qur'an. The Qur'an was first revealed in this blessed month.

Ibn 'Abbas said that The Prophet Peace be Upon him used to meet Archangel Gabriel every night during Ramadhan to revise the Qur'an with him. (Narrated by Imam Bukhari and Muslim)

It was also narrated from Aisha R.A that the Prophet Muhammad PBUH said: "The one who is proficient with the Qur'an will be with the noble and righteous scribes (the angels), and the one who reads it and stumbles over it, finding it difficult, will have two rewards." (Narrated by Imam Ibn Majah)

One should increase in reading the Qur'an in the blessed month of Ramadhan. If one is proficient in reading it, he will have the angels be with him! And for those who are struggling, who puts in more effort than the one who is proficient, that person receives twice the reward. This is Allah's generosity and love for those who read the book of Allah!

## **Tarawih prayers**

Tarawih Prayers are done after Isya' and these prayers are special because it is only done in the month of Ramadhan.

Abu Hurairah (May Allah be pleased with him) reported: The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) said, "He who observes optional prayer (Tarawih prayers) throughout Ramadan, out of sincerity of Faith and in the hope of earning reward, will have his past sins pardoned." [Narrated by Imam Bukhari and Muslim]

## **Charity & sharing food with others**

Islam strongly encourages charity and providing food for others for the sake of Allah S.W.T.

The Prophet PBUH said, 'Whoever feeds a person breaking his fast will earn the same reward as him, without anything being lessened from the reward of the fasting person'. [Narrated by Imam Tirmidhi]

Imagine feeding 3 people. You will gain the reward of 3 fasts, not including yours!

## **Sending salutations to The Prophet (PBUH)**

Allah says in The Qur'an 33:56

“Indeed, Allah showers His blessings upon the Prophet, and His angels pray for him. O you who have believed! Invoke Allah’s blessings upon him, and salute him with worthy greetings of peace.”

Ubay ibn Ka’b narrated that he said to the Prophet PBUH: “Shall I devote all my supplications to send Selawat upon you?” The Prophet said, “If so, you will be freed from your worries (Allah will remove your problems) and your sins will be forgiven.” (Narrated by Imam At-Tirmizi)

When sending one Salutation to the Prophet, the person will receive tenfold salutations from Allah Almighty Himself. The simplest way of sending salutation is: [Allahumma Solli Wa-sallim ‘Alaa Sayyidina Muhammad]

Meaning: (Oh Allah send your salutations and blessings on Our Prophet Muhammad). It is also recommended to add (Wa ‘ala Aali Sayyidina Muhammad) after it, which means ‘and on the Family of Our Prophet Muhammad’

## **Asking for Forgiveness from Allah (Istighfar)**

Ibn 'Abbas (May Allah be pleased with him) said: The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) said, "If anyone constantly seeks pardon (from Allah), Allah will appoint for him a way out of every distress, a relief from every anxiety and will provide sustenance for him from where he expects not."

Simplest way to seek forgiveness from Allah: [Astagh-firullah]

Meaning: (I seek forgiveness from Allah)

## **Punctuality of Prayers & Being Good to your Parents**

Narrated by Imam Bukhari from `Abdullah:

I asked the Prophet (ﷺ) "Which deed is the dearest to Allah?" He replied, "To offer the prayers at their early stated fixed times." I asked, "What is the next (in goodness)?" He replied, "To be good and dutiful to your parents". We can learn that the most beloved deed to Allah, is to offer our prayers on time and to do good to our parents with the intention of pleasing Allah SWT. Doing good to our parents include practicing good manners, forgiving them when they have wronged us, spending and caring for them.

## Seeking knowledge for the sake of Allah

It was reported that:

The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) said, "He who follows a path in quest of knowledge, Allah will make the path of Jannah easy to him. The angels lower their wings over the seeker of knowledge, being pleased with what he does. The inhabitants of the heavens and the earth and even the fish in the depth of the oceans seek forgiveness for him."

The superiority of the learned man over the devout worshiper is like that of the full moon to the rest of the stars (i.e., in brightness). The learned, are the heirs of the Prophets who bequeath neither dinar nor dirham but only that of knowledge; and he who acquires it, has in fact acquired an abundant portion." [Narrated by Imam Abu Dawud and At- Tirmidhi]

Seeking knowledge is key to attaining the pleasure of Allah SWT. One should seek knowledge from reliable sources, such as those provided by MUIS and Darul Arqam, in order to avoid falling into wrong ideologies. When seeking knowledge, it is important to always keep a humble heart, knowing that the knowledge attained is from and given by Allah and Allah owns everything.

## Building good character (Akhlaq)

Abu Huraira reported: The Messenger of Allah, PBUH said, “Do you know who is bankrupt?” They said, “The one without money or goods is bankrupt.” The Prophet said, “Verily, the bankrupt of my nation are those who come on the Day of Resurrection with prayers, fasting, and charity, but also with insults, slander, consuming wealth, shedding blood, and beating others. The oppressed will each be given from his good deeds. If his good deeds run out before justice is fulfilled, then their sins will be cast upon him and he will be thrown into the Hellfire.” (Narrated by Imam Muslim)

Hastening in good deeds and seeking knowledge is essential for a Muslim. However, one must not neglect the importance of good character and morals that have been taught by the Prophet Peace be Upon him. Good character should be practiced when dealing with family, spouses, friends, neighbours and even those who have wronged us. Good character is nourished by learning more about the Prophet Peace be Upon him and emulating his traits.

Allah says in The Qur'an 33:56

“And Verily, you (O Muhammad **صلى الله عليه وسلم**) are on an exalted (standard of) character.”

## **Loving each other for the sake of Allah**

Abu Huraira reported: The Messenger of Allah, peace and blessings be upon him, said: Verily, Allah will say on the Day of Resurrection: Where are those who love each other for the sake of My glory? Today, I will shelter them in My shade on a day when there is no shade but Mine. (Narrated by Imam Muslim)

## **Loving Allah and The Prophet PBUH**

Abu Dharr reported: He said, "O Messenger of Allah, a man loves a person, but he cannot do good deeds like they do."

The Messenger of Allah, peace and blessings be upon him, said, "You, O Abu Dharr, will be with those you love." Abu Dharr said, "I love Allah and his messenger." The Prophet said, "Verily, you will be with those you love." (Narrated by Imam Abu Dawud)

# LAYLATUL QADR

---

---



## Laylatul Qadr

Laylatul Qadr, often translated as the Night of Destiny or the Night of Power. Allah SWT sent down a whole Surah regarding this night. (Surah Al-Qadr)

(Quran 97: 1-5) "Indeed, it is We Who sent this Quran down on the Night of Glory. And what will make you realize what the Night of Glory is? The Night of Glory is better than a thousand months. That night the angels and the spirit descend, by the permission of their Lord, for every decreed matter. It is all peace until the break of dawn."

Imam 'Abdullah Al-Haddad mentioned:

Watch carefully for the Night of Destiny [Laylatul-Qadr], which is better than a thousand months. It is the blessed night in which all affairs are wisely decided. [Al-Qur'an 44:4] The one to whom it is unveiled sees the blazing lights, the open doors of heaven, and the angels ascending and descending, and may witness the whole of creation prostrating before Allah, its Creator.

Regardless of which day it is on, the believer should devote himself completely to Allah during every night of this month in the hope of coinciding with that night which has been kept secret from him. And Allah knows best.

# SUPPLICATIONS FOR THE LAST TEN NIGHTS

- Du'a taught by The Prophet PBUH to his wife to recite on Laylatul Qadr:

اللَّهُمَّ إِنَّكَ عَفُوفٌ تُحِبُّ الْعَفْوَ فَاعْفُ عَنِّي

Allahumma innaka afuwun tuhibbul 'afwa fa'fu 'anni  
(O Allah, You are Forgiving and love forgiveness, so forgive me)

- Du'a for goodness in this world and next:

رَبَّنَا آتِنَا فِي الدُّنْيَا حَسَنَةً وَفِي الْآخِرَةِ حَسَنَةً وَقِنَا عَذَابَ النَّارِ

Rabbana aatina fiddunya hasanah, wa fil akhirati hasanah, waqina azaaban naar

(Our Lord, give us in this world [that which is] good and in the Hereafter [that which is] good and protect us from the punishment of the Fire)

- Du'a for knowledge, sustenance and recovery:
